This is a generalist position working with clients across the age range from children to adolescents to elders. You will conduct assessments and provide counseling and case management services to clients and their families. You will provide educational and therapeutic group work services as required. Travel on gravel roads and in light aircraft may be required. The ability to speak Cree would be an asset in this position.
