Good response to H1N1 clinics leads to change in schedule for La Ronge area

Over 800 individuals received their H1N1 vaccination at the Elks Hall in Air Ronge yesterday, Wednesday, November 4, 2009, the first day of public clinics. The health region is pleased with the good response, and is hopeful it will be able to wind down its mass clinics by the middle of next week. The schedule for the clinics in the La Ronge area has been adjusted accordingly.

Because there are cases of H1N1 flu in our northern communities, residents are encouraged to take advantage of the clinics and get their vaccine this week, if possible, or early next week. The current schedule is as follows:

Friday, November 6, 2009 Elks Hall, Air Ronge 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Monday, November 9, 2009 Legion Hall, La Ronge 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Tuesday, November 10, 2009 Legion Hall, La Ronge 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Additional clinics will be scheduled as necessary.

Please bring your Saskatchewan Health Card and wear a short-sleeved T-shirt. You will be required to complete a consent form.

The unadjuvanted vaccine for pregnant women under 20 weeks is now available in the La Ronge area.
