RHA NOTES **from the meeting held** **April 28, 2011** **La Ronge, SK**

- ◆ Ron Woytowich, in his new role as Chairperson, welcomed Miles Bean as a new member of the Mamawetan Churchill River Regional Health Authority.
- ◆ The Board renewed privileges for physicians in the Mamawetan Churchill River Health Region, as recommended by the Senior Medical Officer. Currently, there are 13 active medical staff based in La Ronge, and 12 physicians who perform clinics in Sandy Bay on an itinerant basis.
- ◆ The Audit & Finance Committee reported on its review of the draft financial statements for the 2010-11 fiscal year. The Board agreed to apply the operating surplus toward clearing the accumulated deficit from previous years in the amount of \$303,738, with the remainder to be transferred to the capital fund. The audited statements are expected to be presented to the Board at its next regular meeting on May 19, 2011.
- ◆ The Board reviewed the region's draft strategic plan for 2011-12 developed in response to the strategic and operational directions established by the Ministry of Health and the Accountability Document for the health region. Initiatives have been established in relation to the following pillars: the health of the individual, the health of the population, providers, sustainability and supportive processes.
